4:00 p.m. Take a walk through the **North Wintergarden Arboretum** and enjoy the flower gardens, different trees, and shrubs.

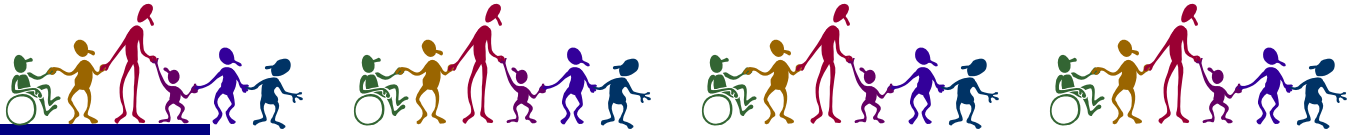
5:30 p.m. Take a short ride over to the **Bowling Green Wind Turbines** and watch modern science in action during sunset.
