### A Blast From The Past- A Day with BG Museums

#### An Open-Ended Tour with your choice of 5 Museums to visit:

- **American Civil War Museum of Ohio**- This museum is designed to educate about the Civil War with the various exhibits offered. Come in and look at the different mannequins and displays to make you really feel like you are on the warfront. NOTE: This museum is only open on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
- **Historical Construction Equipment Association**- If construction equipment and machinery is one of your interests, than you will be in amazement at what this site has to offer. NOTE: This museum is only open by appointment only at (419) 352-5616.
